Design competition that asks for responses to the condition of Crisis—to consider the forgotten people and places of trauma, to shed light on the void after the cameras have left. What role does design play, and how do we take part in something larger than just responding to a catastrophe. How can the design community address the cycle of crisis proactively? To engage a larger conversation about the invisibility of displacement, the politics of mobilization, and the mechanisms of recovery.

The Challenge

Communicate a proposal that re-contextualizes the displacement of individuals and families from private property into public space as a result of crisis. Explore the conflicts and potentialities that emerge from this inversion, and expound upon the opportunity for an intervention that can be versatile enough to respond to a range of emergency profiles. The design response should not only have a positive impact in the aftermath of a catastrophic event, but also explore the nature of global solutions and long term applications.
